Each team is guaranteed 4 games. All games will take place at the Alberni Valley Multiplex. Schedule will be emailed out to managers and posted around the arena.

The Dressing room and game schedule will be posted on the Arenas TV Screen display. Please ensure the dressing rooms are left clean after your games. Dressing rooms will be inspected after each team is finished – the teams will be responsible for any mess or damage to the change rooms.

Games:

Each game will have a 5 minute warm-up and two 25 minute run time. Total ice time, including warm-up, is 1 hour and 10 minutes. At the end of each game there will be a 5 puck shoot out and awards for MVP and Digger handed out.

Game Sheets:

Game sheets will be ready for approval 30 minutes prior to game start time. The game sheets will be at the raffle table. Please be sure to double check your team information on the sheets, make any corrections as needed before authorizing. Game sheet copies will be available for Managers or Coaches to pick up post game at the raffle table.

Digger and MVP Awards:

At the end of each game the players will line up on the blue lines and the head coach will pick two players from their team, one MVP and one Digger, will receive awards.

Snacks:

There will be a snack table set up near the raffle table (for players only).

Five Puck Shoot Out:

After each game there will be a shoot out. Please quickly line your kids up in front of the player boxes (all players to shoot) as soon as the final buzzer goes off. The team to score the five goals first will win a box of Timbits. If neither team is able to score the five goals, at the end of 2 minutes a winner will be determined by the team that scored the most goals. In the event of a tie a coin toss will be done to decide which team wins the Timbits.

The Rules:

1. The rules will comply with BC Hockey and VIAHA
2. Any verbal abuse of on-ice officials will result in the person being told to leave the arena. No abuse of any kind will be tolerated on or off ice. This will be at the discretion of the Tournament Coordinator.

3. One certified coach per game is required to be on the ice in addition with one ref as per VIAHA rules. The team number in **RED** on the schedule for each game will be the team required to have a coach on the ice for that game.
4. If you have a concern we request that the Coach or Manager submit written documentation of the specific issue. This can be dropped off at the raffle table for the Coordinator. We will make every effort to resolve the issue immediately. Any decision made by the Tournament Coordinator is final.
5. As per VIAHA rule 3.05 – All players and team officials shall shake hands after the game. Players are required to remove their right hand glove for the handshake.

Conduct:

1. Team Officials will be held responsible for their conduct as well as the conduct of their players and parents on and off the ice, which includes the arena facilities as well as the parking lot. The cost to repair any damage caused by the Team Officials, players or parents will be billed to the Team and/or Association found responsible to such damage.
2. Team officials are responsible for ensuring that all players on their roster are eligible to play and are aware of the rules governing the tournament.
